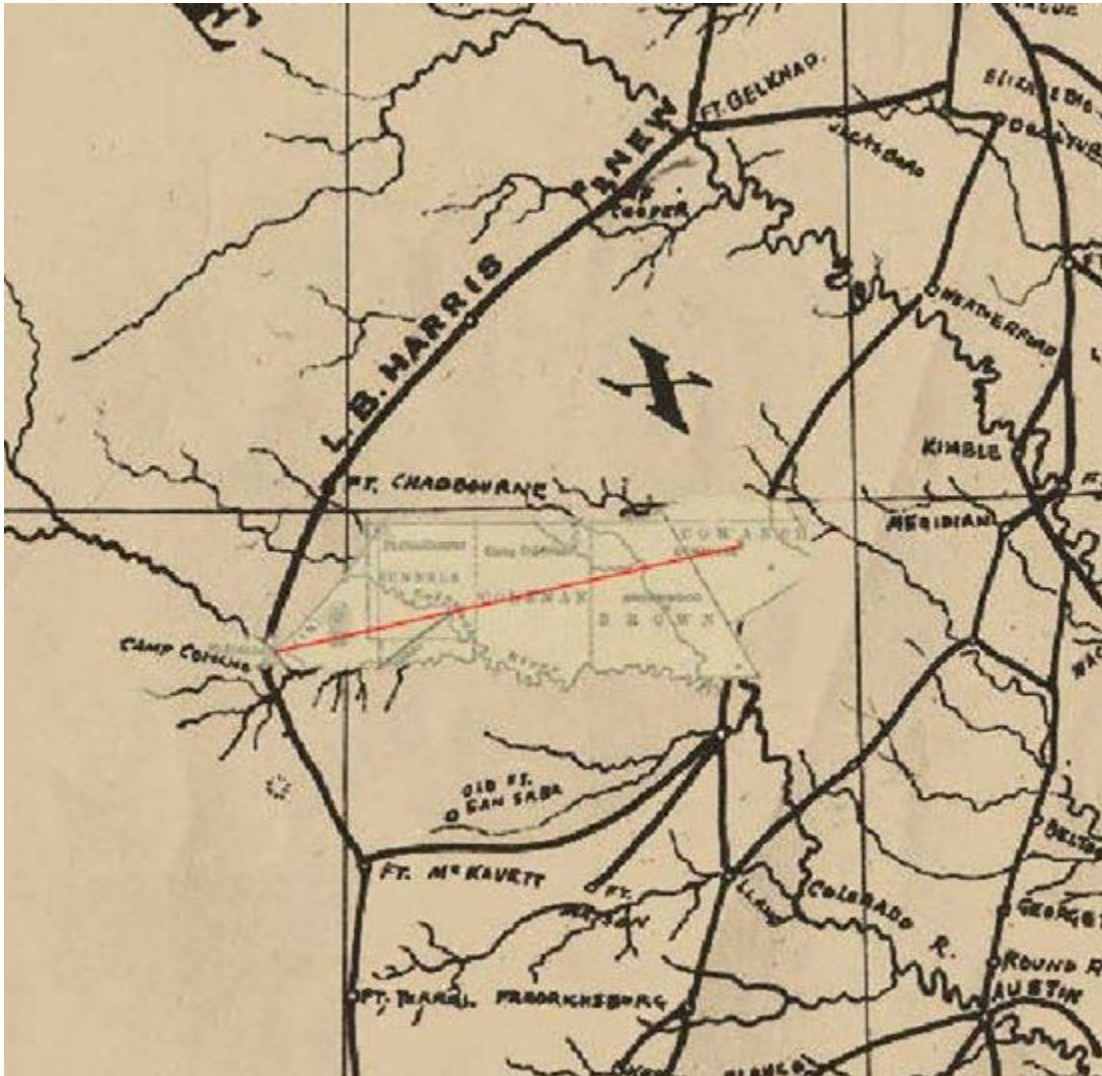

The Major Cattle Trails in Texas and Their Feeder Trails

The Old Chisholm Cattle Trail and Subsidiary Trails are detailed in this 1873 map above.



This a "hybrid" map showing the cattle trail coming from Ft. Concho (San Angelo) to Comanche, through Brown County. Some have asked for a better

representation of the trail through Brown County, roughly through the Byrd's Store area at the low water crossing on the Pecan Bayou. (not to perfect scale).

There were local cattle drives that went through Brownwood to get to the feeder trails. With the advent of barbed wire fencing and the rail road coming through the Western counties, these trails became a thing of the past.
